Day shift (6:00 AM-2:30 PM) Monday-Friday (Some weekends) Base Wage \$10.30 per hour

Swing (5:00 PM-1:30 AM) Monday-Friday (Some weekends) Base Wage \$10.30 + .25¢ shift premium per hour

Benefits: Various benefit programs are available. Employees may be eligible only after 90 day Introductory Period. Your questions can be answered if you are interviewed.

Introductory Period: All employees hired are subject to a 90 day Introductory Period whereas they will be closely monitored and supervised for performance and progress. Any violation of policies and/or procedures, or behavioral and attitude problems will be cause for employee's discharge. *We reserve the right to end an employee's employment at any time without advance warning or notice.* **Employees are not eligible for any Company Benefits during the 90-day period.**

Requirements for Employment Consideration:

- 1) MUST HAVE A CURRENT, VALID CALIFORNIA DRIVERS LICENSE AND SUBMIT A CLEAN DMV PRINTOUT REPORT, NOT LESS THAN 30 DAYS OLD.
- 2) MUST BE ABLE TO PASS A PRE-EMPLOYMENT PHYSICAL EXAM AND DRUG SCREENING TEST. EXAM IS GIVEN ONLY TO THOSE WE CHOOSE AS CANDIDATES. IN THE FINAL RECRUITING PROCESS. CANDIDATES WHO ARE NOT RECOMMENDED BY DOCTOR FOR EMPLOYMENT, OR WHO FAIL DRUG TEST, WILL NOT BE HIRED.
- 3) APPLICANTS MUST HAVE EMPLOYMENT REFERENCES THAT WE CAN CONTACT AND VERIFY.
- 4) APPLICANTS MUST SATISFACTORILY READ, WRITE, UNDERSTAND AND SPEAK ENGLISH.
- 5) APPLICANTS MUST BE SAFE, RESPONSIBLE DRIVERS AND WORKERS.

The Route Specialist

Our Route Specialist Maintenance Drivers are assigned routes, which normally consist of between 30 and 45 Bus Stop Shelters and/or up to sixty (60) trash receptacle locations. Drivers are required to follow route as stated on Route Sheet, clean and maintain shelters and stops so that they are safe and sanitary. The maintenance of shelters includes, but is not limited to: Washing glass; sweeping and picking up trash in and around shelter; emptying trash receptacle; removing graffiti from glass and metal surfaces; installing advertisement posters; reporting all problems. Route Specialist Maintenance Drivers are also required, when asked, to assist our Repair Specialists and help keep our facilities clean and organized.

Route Specialists are assigned routes according to his/her ability and/or availability. The Route Specialists “own” their assigned routes for an indefinite period allowing a sense of pride in the quality and general condition of the shelters and bus stops on the route. Their work is evaluated frequently with feedback and ongoing training from our experienced Field Supervisors.
